The Ministry of Earth Sciences, Government of India requested for No Objection Certificate to the Principal investigator (Dr. S. Santhosh, Assistant Professor M.M.N.SS College, Kottiyam) of the project named "Wave Ventilator: A Beach Restoration and Anti Sea Erosion Project", so as to get financial support from Ministry of Earth Science (MoES) New Delhi.

The KCZMA discussed the matter in detail and decided to issue No objection Certificate on CRZ angle. The PI shall obtain necessary clearance from the Water Resources Department. It was also decided to appraise the Ministry of Earth Science, New Delhi of the same.

#### Construction of Fishing Harbour at Manjeswaram

The Harbour Engineering Department, Government of Kerala proposes to establish a fishery harbour with two breakwaters on either side of the tidal inlet of Uppla / Manjeswaram river at Manjeswaram in Kasaragod District. The aerial extent of the project is 18.1546 hectare. Reclamation of sea is proposed for an area of 19600m<sup>2</sup>. The break waters are having a length of 1020m. An approach

road and parking area is proposed with a total area of 9888m<sup>2</sup> is also proposed. A bridge is also proposed to connect Uppala Village and Hosabettu village.

The Chief Engineer, Harbour Engineering Division has submitted the proposal for the construction of a fishing harbour at Manjeswaram, Kasargod, with a fish handling Capacity of 9810 tonne/annum. The Authority discussed the proposal in detail and decided to grant CRZ clearance.

A Sub Committee is also constituted with Dr. A. Ramachandran, School of Industrial Fisheries, CUSAT; and Dr. Kamalakshan Kokkal from the

Environment Group of KSCSTE. The Sub Committee shall submit their report to the Authority.

# Destruction of Mangroves in Asramam of Kollam for tourism- complaint by Sasthra Sahithya Parishath

Destruction of Mangroves in the Ashtamudi backwater near Kollam by DTPC Kollam for Tourism Projects in the Astamudi Backwater near Ashramam, Kollam.

The Authority discussed the matter in detail and found that destruction of mangroves and other activities in CRZ area amount to violation of the provisions of CRZ Notification and EP Act 1986.

It was also decided to issue direction for taking effective steps to protect the mangroves to District Collector, Kollam and Panchayath authorities, intimating the same to the LSGD Secretary.

# Construction of an Ayurvdic Resort at Punnayur Grama Panchayath, Thrissur District.

## **Complaint on the Reclamation of Cochin Backwaters**

The Secretary, Association for Environmental Protection Council Aluva lodged a complaint on the reclamation of Cochin Backwater and the construction of high-rise buildings in the area. Copy of the complaint is attached herewith.

The main points raised in the complaint are.

- 1. The construction of Lulu Convention centre in the reclaimed land between the lake and Bolgatty palace road.
- 2. GCDA is planning to implement the 2<sup>nd</sup> stage development of Marine Drive Scheme. As per the available information it is proposed to reclaim 150 hectares of backwater.

The Authority discussed the case in detail and decided to issue notice to the GCDA, Mulavukad Panchayath and Cochin Corporation. Information on this will be sent to the District Collector, Ernakulam and the Secretary, LSGD.

### Construction of a Convention and Exhibition Centre in Bolgatty Island

Construction of Lulu Convention and Exhibition Centre in Bolgatty Island at Mulavukad Village with 1,49,820 m². Plot area 1,05,900 m², Built up area 1,49,820m², Hotel rooms (217 Nos)+ Apartments (572 Nos), Convention Centre(3400 seats) + Restaurant and Health club in Survey No 31/4 & 31/20 Bolgatty island at Mulavukad Village, Kanayannur Taluk, Ernakulam District, Kerala.

The Authority examined the case in detail and decided to issue notice under Section 5 of EP Act 1986 to the Secretary, Cochin Corporation, and Project Proponent, as CRZ violation took place in the area. Information as above will be sent to the District Collector, Ernakulam and the Secretary, LSGD.

### <u>Violation of CRZ norms - Construction of Hotel Crown Plaza,</u> <u>Maradu, Ernakulam by M/S KGA Hotels and Resorts (P) Ltd-reg.</u>

Show Cause Notice was issued to Sri.K.G Abraham, KGA Hotels and Resorts (P) Ltd. Ernakulam, for undertaking construction in the CRZ area of Maradu Municipality (Erstwhile Maradu Grama Panchayat) in violation to the provisions of CRZ Notification 1991, as decided by the KCZMA in the previous meeting. The matter came up for consideration before the Authority during the period 2008-2009. After conducting site inspection and examining the CRZ status report of the area, it was found that, the construction was made in the No Development Zone (NDZ) of CRZ-III area. Notice was issued accordingly and also direction was given to the District Collector, Ernakulam to stop all the illegal constructions.

Adv. Prakash C. Vadakkan, Standing Counsel, KCZMA appraised the Authority on the status of the case pending in the Hon'ble High Court in this regard and also of another case related to the construction made by KAPICO Resorts Pvt. Ltd at Alapuzha.

The Authority discussed the matter in detail in consideration of the reply received from the Proponent and decided to issue instruction under section 5 of EP Act 1986, to the Secretary, Marad Grama Panchayath to demolish the building, with intimation to the District Collector, Ernakulam and the Secretary, LSGD in the wake of the opinion of the Standing Counsel that there would not be any legal objection in issuing such instruction. The Standing Counsel shall be informed of the said instruction to bring the same to the notice of the Hon'ble High Court.

It was decided to hold a special meeting of the Authority to consider all the pending similar cases in the High Court. The Standintg Counsel informed that there are a number of very serious cases pending in the High Court. Detailed agenda notes and files related to such cases shall be presented before the Authority for taking urgent decisions in this regard.

each case and Rs.1,000/- for Stationery charges. The expenditure shall be met

from the budgetary provisions of KSCSTE for KCZMA.

The duties and responsibilities of the Standing Counsel also shall be

specified clearly. The terms of appointment shall be initially for a period of one

year.

The proposal for the fixation of the terms and conditions of the appointment

of the Standing Counsel, for KCZMA has been considered by the Authority.

The Authority discussed the case and decided to approve the

recommendation such as retainer fee of Rs.5000/-, Rs.3000/- for each case

and Rs.1000/- as stationery charges. Initially the appointment shall be for a

period of one year.

The Standing Counsel shall attend to all court cases where KCZMA is

the respondent/ petitioner and shall give legal advice to the Authority. He

shall furnish bimonthly report to the Authority on the status of the cases

pending.
